Student Supplies for September

High school does not typically have a student supply list. We would advise students have a 3-ring binder per course, plus various pens, and pencils. We are no longer selling calculators at the business office, but we have included an information sheet on recommended calculators that can be purchased at a variety of stores such as Staples and BestBuy.

Students writing Diploma and/or Common Summative Assessments (CSA) exams must use a Government of Alberta authorized calculator. Please review with your teacher the list of authorized calculators prior to purchasing a calculator. Note that students will **not** be permitted to use an unauthorized calculator for these assessments.

Student Timetables and August Registration Days

Student Timetables will be available for students to access August 24th through their PowerSchool account.

Student Registration Days at the end of August are **MANDATORY** and all students are to come in during their assigned time on their assigned days. These Registration Days are used to:

- Make any timetable changes, due to having completed a Summer School course
- Address and questions about your timetable with your cohort Assistant Principal
- Take the school photo for the yearbook and student ID
- Receive their student ID and lanyard **STUDENTS ARE REMINDED THAT THE SCHOOL ISSUED LANYARDS AND ID CARDS ARE TO BE WORN AT ALL TIMES IN THE SCHOOL...NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- Receive their locker assignment: all Grade 10 & 11 students will automatically be assigned a locker. If any Grade 12 students would like a locker, please ask on your registration day and one will be assigned
- Purchase bus passes
- Pay any fees

This process helps to better prepare students for the first days of school.

Only students will be permitted in the building on their assigned day due to the volume of registered students.

If you do not have a course schedule on the day of your registration it may be because you are **new to our district or you never selected courses on registration day in March**. Please come to the office and we will print one out for you. You can also have a parent call the office starting Aug 17th, and we will get the Parent PowerSchool set up so you can view your schedule. Student PowerSchool will not be set up until you begin here.

Report Cards (PowerSchool)

Orientation Day for Grade 10 students – September 2 – 08:30-12:00 PM

Grade 10 Orientation Day will take place on September 2, 2026. This day will be for Grade 10 students only. We will start our day at 8:30 am in the large gym. Students will be introduced to our administrative team, support services and Students Union members. The day will include a run through of student schedules, introduction to classroom teachers, and a tour of our amazing school. We are so excited to welcome our new Spartans to Archbishop O'Leary High School! Students must ensure they have their id and lanyard with them in order to enter the building.

Course Changes

A great deal of time and effort is required of school staff to ensure each and every O'Leary student timetable matches the courses requested. However, depending on your core course and option choices this is not always possible.

Course changes will only be made for the following reasons:

- Incomplete schedule - missing required courses for high school completion and/or post-secondary
- Missed registration
- Course conflict
- Change in course marks necessitates a change in course stream (i.e. 30-1 to 30-2)
- Course(s) completed during summer school
- Course changes will not be considered for reasons other than those listed above
 - **Please note that you must have your course changes completed before you go through the registration process (i.e. Pay fees, photos, school ID)**

Student timetables may also be adjusted by the school should it be determined that the course prerequisite has not been met.


Academic Prerequisites




